

***Professional Animal Scientist***  
**Institutional Electronic Access Agreement (IEAA)**

**1. This agreement** between the subscriber identified below (“Subscriber” or “you”) and the American Registry of Professional Animal Scientists (ARPAS) grants the Subscriber and authorized users (defined below) at the Subscriber’s institution the right to access the online version of the *Professional Animal Scientist (PAS)* when the Subscriber maintains a current print subscription to PAS. Subscriptions are based on the calendar year, and access to the electronic version of PAS will be activated after this form is completed and sent to the ARPAS Headquarters and other conditions of subscription are met (i.e., current subscription to the print version of PAS verified), subject to the terms of this agreement.

**2. Member Login:**

Section 3 below defines the authorized users who will be allowed access to the online version of PAS. Authorized users will be recognized and authorized by a Member ID Number and Password. This password will be given at the time online access is approved.

### **3. Authorized Users:**

ARPAS' grant to the Subscriber and authorized users at the Subscriber's institution of access to the online version of PAS extends only to the Subscriber and such authorized users individually and may not be transferred or extended to others. For purposes of this agreement, "authorized users" means only the authorized clients and the employees, faculty, staff, and students officially affiliated with the Subscriber. For institutional subscribers, there is no limit on the number of authorized users from one campus at any given time. Subscribing institutions are expected to make all reasonable efforts to enable access only to authorized users: employees, faculty, staff, and students officially affiliated with the subscribing institution and authorized clients of the subscribing institution's library facilities. These authorized clients may include "walk-in" patrons who are not necessarily affiliated with the subscribing institution but who are using the library facilities. Authorized users also include persons affiliated with remote sites or campuses of the subscribing institution that are served only by the subscribing institution's library.

For academic institutions, an authorized site is defined as a contiguous campus community or buildings located within the same city and reporting to the same administrative body. Branch campuses in other cities that hold a subscription to the printed version of PAS must retain their print subscriptions and register their own password in order to gain electronic access to the online journal. For nonacademic institutions, sites are defined as geographically separate units. Each unit of a nonacademic research organization that holds a print subscription to PAS must retain that subscription and register its own password. Staff directly affiliated with the organization but situated in geographic locations that do not hold a print subscription can also be granted online access.

Unauthorized use of the password for access to the online version of PAS, with or without the Subscriber's knowledge, is a breach of this agreement and a violation of ARPAS' copyrights. The Subscriber is responsible for taking reasonable measures to prevent access by unauthorized persons to its password and to ensure that authorized users observe the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement. The Subscriber shall be responsible for storage, display, access control, and security measures.

### **4. Permitted Use:**

The Subscriber and authorized users are permitted access to the online version of PAS and may download or print text or other information from the online journal solely for the private use or research of the Subscriber and the authorized user. The Subscriber and each authorized user agrees to use this online access in a way that conforms with all applicable laws and regulations. The Subscriber and each authorized user specifically agrees not to make any attempt to gain unauthorized access to any other system or network. The licensee may include either paper or electronic copies of items from the online form of the journal in coursepacks in print or digital form for sale and/or distribution to authorized users in connection with classroom instruction and/or in reserves (print or digital) developed by the licensee's libraries. Subscribing institutions may download and store articles for future use while their subscription is active, and the institution itself is responsible for developing an archive of electronic files.

## **5. Usage Restrictions:**

Altering, recompiling, reselling, redistributing, publishing, or republishing of the text of articles from the online version of PAS in any form or medium is prohibited. The electronic form may be used as a source for interlibrary loan (ILL) whereby articles can be printed and these print copies be delivered via postal mail or fax to fulfill ILL requests from an academic, research, or other noncommercial library. Copies must be made in compliance with Section 108 of the Copyright Act of 1976 and with guidelines developed by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works (CONTU Guidelines), the text of which is available as part of U.S. Copyright Office Circular 21.

ARPAS shall not be required to distribute, and the Subscriber shall not redistribute, text from PAS Online to a country where the export thereof is prohibited by U.S. law or regulation.

## **6. Duration of Agreement:**

This agreement will become effective upon receipt by ARPAS of the agreement signed by you and, subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement, will remain in effect while you maintain a current subscription to the print version of PAS. Barring termination of this agreement for any of the reasons stated below, this agreement will automatically renew at the end of the calendar year. Thus, a new IEAA form need **not** be submitted for each subscription term. If your renewal is not received prior to January 1 you may experience a lapse in access until the renewal has been processed. Subscriptions that have lapsed for a period longer than 6 months should be accompanied by a new IEAA form. This agreement will terminate at the earliest of the following dates:

- a. January 1 of the year following the subscription year.
- b. Immediately, if any term or condition of this agreement is violated for any reason, knowingly or unknowingly.
- c. Following 30 days' prior written notice by ARPAS of any change in the terms of this agreement, receipt by ARPAS of notice from you in writing, via mail, E-mail, or fax, that you do not accept such changes. In the absence of any such objection to you, ARPAS' new terms will apply.
- d. Immediately, if a failure of performance of an agency outside ARPAS' control cannot be rectified.

## **7. Copyright:**

The online version of PAS is copyrighted by ARPAS and is subject to all applicable copyright, database protection, and other rights of ARPAS as copyright owner and publisher under the laws of the United States and other countries. Copyright notices in PAS may not be removed, obscured, or modified in any way.

### **8. Failure of Performance:**

Following online access approval, you will be permitted to attempt access to the online version of PAS at any time. ARPAS, however, will not be liable for any delay, downtime, transmission error, software or equipment incompatibilities, force majeure, or other failure of performance. ARPAS may have contracted with one or more outside agencies to provide the online service. ARPAS will seek to ensure that all services are provided to outside agencies as negotiated and will use commercially reasonable efforts to correct any material performance problem brought to its attention and may suspend performance pending such correction. ARPAS' responsibility to the Subscriber and authorized users does not extend beyond such endeavors.

### **9. Official Version of Record:**

ARPAS will use commercially reasonable efforts to ensure that the content of the online version corresponds to that of the print version of PAS, but ARPAS does not guarantee that it does. In the event of any discrepancy between the print and online version, the print version will be the official version of record.

### **10. Disclaimer of Warranties; Limitation of Liability; Indemnification**

ARPAS warrants that it is entitled to grant the licenses granted in this agreement. EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN THE PRECEDING SENTENCE, ARPAS MAKES NO WARRANTY OR REPRESENTATION OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WITH RESPECT TO THE ONLINE VERSION OF PAS, INCLUDING ITS QUALITY, ORIGINALITY, SUITABILITY, SEARCHABILITY, OPERATION, PERFORMANCE, MERCHANTABILITY, OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. ARPAS SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR EXEMPLARY, SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR OTHER DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE SUBSCRIPTION OR LICENSES GRANTED HEREUNDER, THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE ONLINE JOURNAL, ARPAS' PERFORMANCE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT, TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT BY ARPAS OR THE LOSS OF DATA, BUSINESS, OR GOODWILL, EVEN IF ARPAS IS ADVISED OR AWARE OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. IN NO EVENT SHALL THE TOTAL AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF ARPAS FOR ANY CLAIMS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF ANY BREACH OR TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT EXCEED THE TOTAL AMOUNT PAID BY THE SUBSCRIBER TO ARPAS FOR THE ONLINE JOURNAL SUBSCRIPTION. No claim may be made against ARPAS unless suit is filed thereon within one (1) year after the event giving rise to the claim.

The Subscriber assumes sole responsibility for all use of the online version of PAS by the Subscriber and each authorized user and agrees to indemnify and hold ARPAS harmless from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, expenses (including attorneys' fees and experts' costs, penalties and fees, if any, for the enforcement of this agreement and otherwise for ARPAS' defense of indemnified claims), losses and threatened losses arising from, or in connection with, any breach of this agreement, including without limitation, claims of unauthorized use.

**General:**

This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supercedes any prior communication between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. Subject to termination under Section 6, this agreement may be amended only by a written instrument signed by both parties.

The subscriber must pay any taxes, other than taxes arising out of ARPAS' net income, arising out of the Subscriber's use of the online version of PAS and/or the rights granted under this agreement.

The Subscriber may not transfer or assign its rights under this agreement. The provisions of Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 9, and 10 hereof shall survive any expiration or termination of this agreement.

I have read and agree to adhere to and abide by all the terms and conditions stated above, and I certify that I am authorized to sign this agreement on behalf of the Subscribing Institution as identified in Section 1. I also have read and understand this agreement and agree to abide by all guidelines set forth by ARPAS.
